**DIGITAL CORNER**

**Medium Format and Digital**

**Q:** Does a top-of-the-line digital SLR replace a medium format film camera? In other words, are the results about the same as far as image size, clarity, sharpness, etc.?

**A:** A top-end DSLR will compete with 35mm film resolution in most cases. There are notable exceptions where film scores (low light, etc.), there are fewer times when digital wins out (mainly "instant gratification" factor). In my opinion, digital has a long way to go to compete with MF particularly with the "look" of MF - e.g., the H-U-G-E depth of field available on landscape shots, and even 35mm film simply cannot compete.
