DIGITAL CORNER

Manual Settings on Digital Cameras

Q: I have just purchased a digital camera and I am overwhelmed. Where do I start? I want to learn and master manual exposure, but it seems like there is much more to deal with than with a film camera. I'm reading the manual, and trying to figure out the correct settings, but I'm not sure I'm doing it right.

A: Mastering exposure is no harder with DSLR than with film SLR. It still comes down to selecting the shutter speed and aperture. With DSLR you get some advantage in that besides using the internal light meter you can instantly review the image and the histogram (range of tonality captured) in the LCD.

Digital SLRs are more complicated/involved than film SLRs. Besides relatively simple composition, focus and exposure, the camera includes controls equivalent to making film choices (ISO speed, level of color saturation), color balance filters (white balance), and take on all the details of post-processing your images - equivalent to developing your own film plus enlarge/crop/adjust color/tone balance/ etc. of the prints.

It is important to note that DSLRs are geared more for creating RAW files and doing post-processing in an editor like Photoshop than in creating .jpg files to print or display on the web without processing (though the in-camera settings for Contrast/Sharpness/Saturation can be adjusted to that purpose).
