**Friends of Rural Roads** is an advocacy group for the few remaining miles of gravel roads in the county (58 miles), 58 Roads.

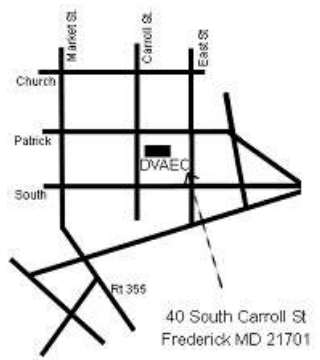
We encourage anyone so inclined to take photos of any of these roads.

Another fabulous gravel road is Bennies Hill Road - just south of Middletown. I have recently learned that the Bennies Hill Bridge is on the National Register. It meanders along the Catoctin Creek.
