## Critique Judge for April: Missy Loewe

Missy Loewe is the academic dean of the *Washington School of Photography* in Bethesda, Maryland. Starting in the photography field in 1997, she has seen her work selected for books, brochures, magazines, government buildings, gallery shows, and museum walls. Her corporate client list includes Greyhound, The Miss America Organization, and the Sydney Natural History Museum.

Missy has also written and photographed for numerous published books, authored magazine articles, and is the board president of Capitol Arts Network. A fan of historical and alternative processes, she explores bromoil, Polaroid transfer, and cyanotype as time permits. She lives in Gaithersburg, MD but book projects often find her in Charleston, SC and her native Pacific Northwest.

## Changes to Photo Category Definitions

Where does this come from?

These guidelines have been adapted directly from those employed by the Associated Press in determining when a photo crosses the line from "photograph" to "photo illustration". It is increasingly clear that manipulated images (regardless of the method of manipulation) are a beautiful and worthy art form whose roots are clearly within the traditions of photography.

There are now three categories for prints: **Black & White**, **Color**, and **Photo Effects**. The slide category has been eliminated.

These categories will apply to Annual, Juried Competition, for In-House Critique/Competitions, the Color and B&W Categories will be combined into Novice and Advanced. There will be no division of Novice/Advanced in the Photo Effects Category.
