## **Creature Feature: Peter Foiles**

I am a native born and raised Oregonian who moved to the Hudson Valley Region of New York in 1983. My first exposure to photography was at the age of 6, with my older brother as he learned the basics of B&W darkroom work. For my 16th birthday I received my first camera, a Canon Ft-QL with 50/1.4 lens. It was manual focus with stop-down metering but I still managed to get some decent basketball photos while serving as a high school yearbook staff photographer.

During high school and college I had access to a darkroom in my parents' basement and became a modestly accomplished B&W printer and experimented with developing my own E6 slides and making Cibachrome prints. After graduate school, my wife and son joined me in the move to New York. My hobby shifted from photography to computers where I taught myself some programming and built several computers over the years. Photography was only a family snapshot activity.



When my camera died in 1998, I bought a more modern SLR and my interest in photography was rekindled. I was associated with three different photography clubs over the years, serving as President of one. To merge my computer interests and photography, I started scanning my slides and negatives to make prints. Then I noticed that the new P&S digital cameras were capable of making prints of way higher quality than I thought they should. I became an early adopter of digital starting with the Canon D30. My taste in photographic subjects is rather eclectic, my current favorites are urban landscapes and street photography, whatever that is.
