WORKSHOP OPPORTUNITY

Dan Scenna and Jerry Bohnenbust announce the first workshop in an ongoing winter series. The first offering is "The Mature Model, Figure Photography in Natural and Studio Lighting".

What:

Two studios, One dedicated to studio strobe lighting. Four lights, and backdrop, used for classic figure and physique photography. The other, a light naturally lit room with a very "homey" feel for use in environmental photography.

Two Instructors: Dan Scenna and Jerry Bohnenblust, both experienced and award winning photogra-

phers. Both have been teaching successful workshops for many years now.

Shoot from slightly below your subject's eyeline!

When shooting portraiture, bend your knees slightly. Shooting from slightly below a person's eyeline is found to be quite flattering for most people.
