## VOLUNTEER PHOTOGRAPHERS FOR C & O CANAL TRUST

The C&O Canal Trust is the primary Friends Group for the C&O Canal National Historical Park. The Trust is a non-profit 501(c)3 organization established in 2007 with the mission to protect, restore, and promote the park.

The C&O Canal Trust hopes to build a bank of volunteer photographers who would be on call to photograph special events up and down the canal – there are quite a few of these each year.

For example, this year there was a serious breach in the canal near

Angler's Bridge, and in 2009 several of the old lockhouses will be restored.

When an event comes up, the C&O Canal Trust would contact the list of volunteer photographers to see who could to participate in the particular event. Selected photos typically appear on the Trust's web site to help explain the event to the public.

If you are in the bank it would not commit you to be at any particular event – it just means you are a person who the Trust can email if there is a need.

This is a chance to be in a beautiful park, do some meaningful public service, and do some photography – how much better could it be?
